What were Joseph's dreams?

Eleven stars, the sun, and the moon bowed to one star

What did Joseph's family think of these dreams?

They thought the dreams meant that they would one day bow down to Joseph

Why did God give Joseph dreams?

To show Joseph the future. God wanted to prepare Joseph for the special job he was going to do when he grew up.

God gave Joseph special dreams. What makes you special?
